

Minute nº1: Meeting of the Jury for the attribution of the Post-Doc Scholarship in the context of the HORIZON EUROPA PROJECT FUNDED BY THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION - FOOD SYSTEMS THAT SUPPORT TRANSITIONS TO HEALTHY AND SUSTAINABLE DIETS, (FEAST)

Selection of candidates

Reference: BIPD 01 2022 FEAST

On the twenty first of July of 2022, the selection jury designated by the Post-Doc Scholarship BIPD_01_2022_FEAST call approved by the IPVC President and composed by Ana Teresa Martins Ferreira de Oliveira (President), Ana Sofia Rodrigues (vowel of the jury) and Manuela Vaz Velho (vowel of the jury), met through videoconference with the purpose of selecting the candidates for the Post-Doc position according to the evaluation criteria.

The Jury evaluated the curricular information present in the application materials submitted by the candidates electronically using the email bolsasinvestigacao@ipvc.pt.

For this evaluation, the jury analyzed the eligibility criteria for the competition, Portuguese Qualification or conferred by a foreign higher education institution and recognized by a Portuguese higher education institution. If the qualification has been conferred by a foreign higher education institution it must be recognized by a Portuguese higher education institution, under the terms of the provisions of article 25 of Decree-Law no. 66/2018, of 16 August, which approves the juridical regime of recognition of academic degrees and diplomas of Higher Education, attributed by foreign higher education institutions, and of paragraph e) of no. 2 of article 4 of Decree-Law no. 60/2018, of 3 August

An eligibility criteria for the competition is a doctoral degree less than three years ago and who comply with the provisions of no. 2 of article 2 of the Research Grant Holder Statute, as amended by Decree-Law no. 123/2019, of 28 August, and also comply with the regime established in the Scientific Research Grant Regulations of the Polytechnic Institute of Viana do Castelo.

Also an eligibility criteria for the competition is that candidates must hold a PhD degree and scientific merit relevant to the work plan.

The candidates Fatima Masood, Catarina Rocha Possidónio Silva, don't meet the eligibility criteria for the competition because they don't have a Doctoral degree.

The candidate Michael Bawa, don't meet the eligibility criteria for the competition because he don't have a Doctoral degree less than three years ago.

The candidates Francyeli Araújo, Eduardo Brandão Ornelas and Kamran Khan, don't meet the eligibility criteria for the competition because they don't have a Portuguese Qualification or conferred by a foreign higher education institution and recognized by a Portuguese higher education institution.



Daniel Nogueira Costa, Lama Al Imam and Nilton Gomes Furtado and Ana Carolina Simões Braga don't meet the eligibility criteria for the competition because they don't have a PhD degree in the scientific area relevant the work plan nor scientific curriculum on the area of the work plan.

The candidates Fernanda Luisa Lüdtke and Susana Isabel Campos were admitted to the selection process and will be interviewed by the jury.

As mentioned in the call, interviews will be held at the discretion of the Evaluation Committee and the outcome of the interview will be then the sole criterion for evaluation if the candidates have the same grade.

The candidates Susana Isabel Campos and Fernanda Luisa Lüdtke will be notified by email by bolsasinvestigacao@ipvc.pt. to be present in a face to face interview at IPVC on the 28th July by 10 am and 10:30 am.

Without anything else to discuss, the current procedure was closed and signed by all the elements of the Jury.
