



Minute nº2: Meeting of the Jury for the attribution of the Post-Doc Scholarship in the context of the HORIZON EUROPA PROJECT FUNDED BY THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION - FOOD SYSTEMS THAT SUPPORT TRANSITIONS TO HEALTHY AND SUSTAINABLE DIETS, (FEAST)

Selection of candidates

Reference: BIPD_01_2022_FEAST

On the twenty eight of July of 2022, the selection jury designated by the Post-Doc Scholarship BIPD_01_2022_FEAST call approved by the IPVC President, and composed by Ana Teresa Martins Ferreira de Oliveira (President), Ana Sofia Rodrigues (vowel of the jury) and Paulo Fernandes (vowel of the jury), met face to face with the purpose of conducting the interview to two candidates for the Post-Doc position according to the evaluation criteria.

The interviews were based specifically on the work plan, namely:

- “ - To contribute to the development and implementation of methodology to assess the impact of food companies on environmental sustainability and obesity; To carry out a baseline assessment of how organisations in Portugal affect the food environment and make preliminary recommendations on how companies can support the transition to healthy/sustainable dietary behaviour.
- Contribute to the development of methodology for mapping government policies (including dietary guidelines) for healthy diets from sustainable food systems at local, national and EU levels, including assessing barriers and facilitators to the implementation of healthy diets from sustainable food systems;
- Contribute to the development of a systemic approach to identify synergies and trade-offs between policy areas relating to both nutrition and sustainability, between actors and between levels of jurisdiction;
- Contribute to the review of dietary patterns and factors influencing dietary behaviours, including actors in the agri-food system;
- Contribute to the development of agri-food sustainability, food consumption behaviour, innovation and development of new food products, food chain management;
- Contribute to mapping and monitoring food behaviour patterns and diets for the general population and vulnerable groups;”

and on the call selection criterium, namely:

- a) Scientific curriculum vitae with publications in international journals with peer-review, in the areas mentioned in the work plan - 30%: Publications in the last 5 years: Q1, Q2, Q3, Q4
- b) Work experience in research projects in the areas mentioned in the work plan - 30%;
- c) Experience in engaging with governmental and organizational actors at different levels of jurisdiction (local, national, European), institutions, organizations and producers associated with the work plan - 20%.
- d) Ability to work independently and good communication skills 10%
- e) Fluency in English and Portuguese 10%

The candidates Susana Isabel Campos and Fernanda Luisa Lüdtkke were interviewed at IPVC on the 28th July by 10 am and 10:30 am. The admitted candidates were graded according to:
